1. NSFA socks purchase

After mentioning to Scott and Eddie, I think we need to jump in regardless of the grant if there is enough interest. our Members should be allowed to pay for an Olympic Coach to come over for a 3-hour workshop at \$600. they just asked me whether the coaching workshop or the refereeing workshop was the priority, and I said the Coaching workshop is as I think we want to establish a relation shop with Mostafa as soon as possible (a bit like we did with Antonio).
